## What is a “HAMCRAM?”

It’s a class where you will review ELEMENT 2 question pool to enable you to pass the Amateur Radio Technician Class License test. From that question pool, you will be given 35 questions on the test. *Morse code is no longer required or part of the test.*

Amateur Radio, or “HAM RADIO” as it is known, has been around since the beginning of radio. For some it is considered a hobby, for others it is a profession. Many Nobel Peace Prize winners were Ham radio operators as well as many inventors during the industrial revolution. Today, a great many people got their start in radio and related professions through their use of Ham Radio.
