Get your Amateur Radio Technician Class FCC License in 1 day!



The New Jersey Emergency Communications Team (<http://NJECT.us>) will be hosting a “HAMCRAM” at 9AM to be held at Saturday January 21st, 2023.

What is a “HAMCRAM?”

It’s a class where you will review ELEMENT 2 question pool to enable you to pass the Amateur Radio Technician Class License test. From that question pool, you will be given 35 questions on the test. *Morse code is no longer required or part of the test.*

If you are involved with radio communications at any level, we strongly recommend this class, as it will help you understand many facets of radio and open a whole new world of radio communications. This entry level license will allow you to work portions of many bands available to amateur radio operators. The real learning begins AFTER you obtain your license and get on the air!

Class Start time 0900 hours Sharp (09:00 am) (*come early!* Doors will open by 0830)

Location: Neptune Twp. OEM building 2nd Floor 2201 Heck Ave Neptune, NJ 07753 Look for posted signs.

Cost to attend the Hamcram and take the Test-\$35.00 (The FCC will be charging and additional \$35 for the license later via an email directly to you).

We are volunteer examiners certified by the ARRL and receive no compensation. There is no age limit to attend or take the test!

Lunch NOT INCLUDED.

Bring: A pencil, pen and paper and PHOTO ID and your PAYPAL Receipt!

Students bring birth certificate.

Testing: Starts about 1300 hours (1:00 pm)

The entrance will be marked with a “HAMCRAM” sign.

Visit the website <http://hamcram.net> and follow the 3 steps necessary to reserve your seat and get all the information required about attending.

No Walk-ins, please register in advance as space is limited.
